(QUEZELCO I) through its Third Party Bids and Awards Committee (TPBAC), invites all interested power suppliers to apply for eligibility and to bid for the Supply and Delivery of QUEZELCO I's Additional Baseload Capacity/Energy Requirement of 5MW with 1MW Yearly Increment for a period of sixty six (66) months commencing on the immediate 26th day of the month upon completion of the conditions precedent to start supply or ERC issuance of Provisional Authority.
