This pertains to the unpaid electric accounts incurred by the different AFP units amounting to Php39 Million. This obligation was emphasized during the House Committee on Appropriations Sponsorship and Budget Deliberation on the FY 2006 DND Budget Proposal last March 16, 2006. The settlement of these accounts with the different electric cooperatives nationwide was reiterated as a prerequisite in the approval of the proposed budget.

Relative bereta, we would like to assure your good office that the AFP has a significant regard for this matter and that various measures have been considered if only to resolve the unpaid accounts.

Likewise, this is to inform you that the unpaid electric accounts will be settled in two-years time upon coordination with the Association of Philippine Electric Cooperatives (APEC) Party List Representatives.
