 SUBJECT : Sitio and Purok Database

Congratulations! To date, the Rural Electrification Program has reached all our provinces and the farthest of our towns, cities and barangays:

The Electric Cooperatives (ECs) gave more meaning to development. Providing power to the countryside resulted to access in bigger opportunities for business and employment, education, communication and information technology, mechanized farming, among others.

All barangays are expected to have full access to power by Year 2008. Only 2,500 barangays more remain unlighted. As we cover more barangays, the next point of interest is the sitio. So far, 3,452 sitios had been energized. Requests for their energization come now as the most pressing, especially from their elected leaders.

To put in a clear plan for sitio energization, we researched on the sitio database. Unfortunately, there is no government office, not even the National Statistics Office (NSO) or the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), which can provide any data or information.

The ECs are the program implementors, and are in a better position to help identify these sitios and puroks in their respective franchise areas. It is necessary then that the sitio database be established for the purpose of program planning and appropriate funding.

To support this, may we request you to facilitate the identification of these sitios and puroks. The Barangay Captains or the Barangay Councils can be a good source of information. Your Institutional Services Department (ISD) should spearhead this Sitio Database Project. The necessary Report Format is provided as attached. We expect to receive your report on or before 30 September 2006, after which a Sitio Master Plan for Energization will be put in place.

This shall be another milestone in the history of the Rural Electrification Program, a program which we are all proud of!
