Pursuant to the recently-issued Guidelines in the Conduct of Appeals/Protests from the Decisions of the Electric Cooperative (EC) Screening Committee, the Deputy Administrator for EDUS exercises appellate jurisdiction over decisions or resolutions of the EC Screening Committee on the (dis)qualifications of candidates to the EC Board of Directors.

Further thereto, please be guided by the following:

1. All protests shall be filed with the EC Screening Committee;
2. The prescribed docket fee shall be paid to the EC which shall then transmit the same to NEA in the form of a check;
3. The verified Protest, its annexes and other pertinent documents shall forthwith be transmitted to NEA. However, for faster electronic transmittal, the digital copies of the said documents shall be forwarded to electionprotest.nea_edus@yahoo.com.ph in PDF format;
4. The EC Screening Committee shall ensure that the fax number or e-mail address of the Protestant/Petitioner shall be indicated in the Protest/Petition for a more expedient service of Our resolution.
