RE: VALIDATION RESULT OF NEA'S 2020 PERFORMANCE SCORECARD

Dear Secretary Cusi and Administrator Juaneza,

This is to formally transmit the validation result of NEA's 2020 Performance Scorecard. Based on the Governance Commission's validation of the GOCC's documentary submissions, NEA obtained an over-all score of **100%** (See *Annex A*). The same is to be posted on NEA's website, in accordance with Section 43 of GCG Memorandum Circular (M.C.) No. 2012-07.¹

In relation to the grant of 2020 Performance-Based Bonus (PBB) to eligible officers and employees, NEA can grant such incentive only upon receipt of a confirmation letter from the Governance Commission. In this regard, the Board is reminded that any unilateral action to release the PBB before the confirmation will be considered as a violation of the Board's fiduciary duty to protect the assets of the GOCC as provided under Section 19 of Republic Act No. 10149.²
