We are pleased to tell you that the PEDRO G. DUMOL LIBRARY will be inaugurated on August 5, 2004. It had been dedicated on June 7, 2002 to the man who was the prime mover of the Philippine Rural Electrification Program. As the commemorative plaque reads “. . . for his shared vision of total electrification with the men and women of this Agency and the 119 electric cooperatives, this Center which serves as the repository of the narratives of rural electrification in the Philippines . . .”


Last year, Fr. Francisco G. Silva started a book donation campaign among NEA and EC officials and employees. From June 2 to October 2, 2002, we were able to raise a cash (for books) of P366,725.00 from NEA employees, P350,00 from the ECs (particularly during the NEA-EC Consultative Conference) and a counterpart fund approved by the NEA Board of Administrators of P350,000.00.

The Library has a total of 3,418 books donated through the efforts of Fr. Silva. They are read by employees of NEA, ECs and even former employees.

As the Secretary has inculcated that the return of investment in books is having a culture of excellence in organizations of electrification workers, we ask you again at this time of Electrification Week Celebration to share your blessings by way of donating a book for the Pedro G. Dumol Library.
