COMELEC RESOLUTION NO. 9036

Deputation of the Department of Energy (DOE) and

Electric Cooperatives (ECs)

The Commission on Elections (COMELEC) issued Resolution No. 9036 entitled, "Deputation of Certain Departments under the Executive Branch, Government-Owned-and-Controlled Corporations and Financial Institutions in Connection with the October 25, 2010 Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Elections".

As deputies of the Commission, the DOE and ECs in the local government units shall perform the following:

- 1. Provide uninterrupted power supply on the day before and on election day, until the termination/conclusion of the canvassing of the election returns and proclamation of the elected officials; and
- 2. Perform such other functions that the Commission may prescribe from time to time.

In this connection, all ECs are strongly advised to closely coordinate with Principals/Officials of public schools, buildings of which are designated as polling places/centers and make sure that all electrical equipment, connections, lighting and other energy fixtures are in good condition. Likewise, coordination with telecommunication offices in your areas is imperative for the insurance of uninterrupted power supply in the transmission and delivery of messages of the COMELEC, its field personnel and deputies during election period.

Finally, all the requisite assistance to the COMELEC and its deputized agencies for the conduct of clean, orderly and peaceful Barangay and SK Elections should be paramount among the ECs' other activities immediately before and during the elections.
